The Public Healthcare in Sandviken is looking for rehabilitation medicine specialists

Main responsibilities and expectations

- The clinic consists of Pain Rehabilitation Team, Brain Rehabilitation Team, Spinal Cord Injury Team.
- The inpatient ward has 12 beds for admitted patients and two day care places.

What's expected of you

- To have medical and rehabilitation medicine specialist titles issued or recognized by the European Union.
- Preferably at least 2–3 years of experience as an independently working specialist.
- Must be able to work independently, collaborate easily, and enjoy team-based work.
- Supervision of physicians in training as junior (BT) or resident (ST) doctors in rehabilitation medicine.
- To be eager to help develop the clinic.
- To be able to complete the intensive Swedish language course, which is part of the MediCarrera program.

Salary and Conditions

- Specialist in Rehabilitation Medicine: minimum SEK 75,600/month

- A free preparing course and intensive online language course for the doctors and the partners.
- A scholarship for the intensive language course of 1200 € monthly.

ABOUT THE CLINIC

Rehabilitation medicine is currently located at Sandviken Hospital in Sandviken. Work takes place on the inpatient ward as well as within one of the clinic's outpatient teams:

- Ward team with neurorehabilitation (primarily acquired brain injury and spinal cord injury)
- Outpatient team for rehabilitation and follow-up of spinal cord injury
- Rehabilitation of patients with acquired brain injury
- Rehabilitation of long-term pain, with a focus on return to work and daily functioning

As a specialist, you will have overall responsibility for the patient's rehabilitation interventions. Together with the clinic's team of physicians, you will be responsible for assessing and prioritizing referrals and actively contribute to the development of the clinic.

What makes the position/clinic attractive?

- Competence from multiple professions contributes to development.
- Significant opportunities to influence the clinic's development in varied work.
- You will work daytime hours, no weekends, no on-call duties.

Population in the catchment area

- Approximately 300,000

Number of employees, residents (ST-läkare), specialists, nurses, and other staff

- Total approximately 70 staff members.
- Specialist doctors, nurses, assistant nurses, physiotherapists, occupational therapists, social workers, psychologists, rehabilitation assistants, recreation leaders, sports instructors, rehabilitation coordinators, head secretaries, and medical secretaries.

Sandviken Sweden

Sandviken is a locality and the seat of Sandviken Municipality, situated in Gävleborg County, Sweden. It's about 25 kilometres west of Gävle and approximately 190 kilometres north of Stockholm. As of 2019, it had a population of 39,234. Sandviken is well-connected by rail, with the journey to Stockholm taking about 2 hours and to Arlanda Airport, Sweden's main international airport, no more than 1.5 hours.

Culturally, Sandviken is vibrant, home to various cultural activities such as the Kulturskolan (extramural music, dance, and drama training), the Sandviken Big Band, and the Sandviken Symphonic Orchestra. The town also features the Sandvikens Art Gallery, which hosts various exhibitions throughout the year. For tourists, attractions include the old industrial villages of Gysinge and Högbo Bruk, which offer historical insights, handicrafts, and outdoor recreation opportunities.

The area is also popular for winter sports, with facilities for downhill skiing and a Snowpark at Kungsberget . For visitors, there are numerous activities and places of interest, including Högbo Bruk, an outdoor recreation area with historical buildings, a mill, and a fragrance center; the Årsjögård open-air museum centered around a reconstructed Viking farm; and the Färnebofjärden National Park along the Dal river. The town also offers various dining, drinking, and accommodation options to cater to visitors' needs .
